KVNF Hosts Story Corp



Story Corp is coming to Paonia and Montrose. This independent nonprofit project has a mission to honor and celebrate one another's lives through listening. Since 2003, tens of thousands of

everyday people have interviewed family and friends through StoryCorps. Each conversation is recorded on a free CD to take home and share, and is archived for future generations at the Library of Congress. Story Corp interviews can also be heard on Morning Edition on National Public Radio.

The Story Corp Airstream comes to Paonia August 24 and will be here until September 21. They will be set up in the parking lot of the Paonia Library and ready to start the first interviews Thursday, August 27. The first week of recording happens August 27 through September 2 from the Montrose Library . The crew begins recording from the booth in the Story Corp Airstream Tuesdays through Saturday in Paonia from Thursday, September 3 until Saturday, September 19. The number of interviews they can take is limited and on a first come, first

serve basis, so make a reservation early. To reserve a date and time to record your story, you can call 800-850-4406 or sign up online at www.storycorp.org.

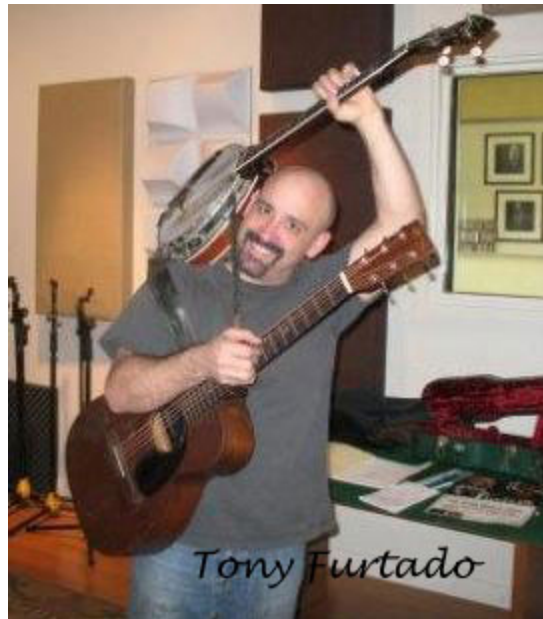
